ALL DRIVERS PLEASE NOTE

There cannot be NO ENGINE NOISE WHATSOEVER before 12 Midday.

FLAG SIGNALS–WAVED YELLOW is bringing the race under control for YOUR SAFETY–SLOW DOWN to 5mph, single file, no overtaking.

DO NOT OVERTAKE PACE CAR IF ON TRACK, YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

If a RED FLAG is shown during a race, you MUST stop immediately and safely. Once you have stopped for a red flag, you MUST NOT move again until an official asks you to do so–offenders will be excluded.

DELIBERATE CONTACT ON THE INFIELD MAY RESULT IN A BAN

DRIVERS ARE REMINDED TO REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLES WHILST ON THE TRACK OR PARKED ON THE INFIELD

However, if you feel that you are in extreme danger (for example fuel leakage, fire, risk of explosion, serious physical injury), then you MUST give a clear 'thumbs down' to the nearest marshal in order that we can either bring the race under caution or stop the race for you to exit safely.

Drivers must drive carefully when they come out on track to line up for their race as there are officials on track - offenders will be penalised.

REMEMBER YOUR PIT SAFETY

NO SMOKING IN THE PIT AREA

WHEN WORKING ON CARS ENSURE THAT THE CAR IS SUPPORTED AND NOT LEFT ON A JACK. IF A HIAB IS TO BE USED ENSURE PART OF THE CAR IS OVER THE FLATBED AREA OF THE LORRY.

ALL FUEL MUST BE KEPT IN SEALED CONTAINERS

CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED IN THE PIT AREA AT ALL TIMES

Only people who are suitably trained should use welding equipment. They should also ensure that they are shielded with non inflammable material, and wearing the correct P.P.E PLEASE TAKE EXTRA CARE.

When leaving the raceway at the end of the meeting, please ensure the safety of others when manoeuvring your race transporter—use a banks man if reversing. Also, please consider other members of the public when leaving our stadium—do so with a minimum amount of noise—this is vital to the continuing support of the local Council and the future of Hednesford Hills Raceway.
