Bonus Attendance Points

Drivers can earn additional attendance points for visiting other Spedeworth / Incarace 'domestic' meetings for which they would not normally receive points.

Full attendance points can only be scored if the driver has booked in advance for the meeting 24hrs prior to the scheduled event. A driver turning up without booking in will score only 5 points for a 10 point meeting, 8 points for a 15 point meeting.

Points Deductions

Drivers booking in for any Banger meeting, failing to cancel, and not showing up, will have the relevant points for that meeting deducted from their total – i.e. if they would have scored 10 points for being at that event they would have 10 points deducted.

The top 17 Spedeworth registered drivers after the final meeting on 21st October 2017 will qualify for the World Championship on Saturday 18th November 2017!
